GOVERNMENT ENGAGEMENTS & ADVOCACY EFFORTS

- Activated - Public Distribution System-PDS, Mid-day Meal and ICDS system through state, city and local government engagement.
- Collaboration with DCP Zone - 5 Ahmedabad for community kitchens for migrants.
- Engagement with District Collectors of Ahmedabad, Gandhinagar and Sabarkantha for the relief work for migrants.
- Letter to CS -Chief Secretary, ACS- Additional Chief Secretary Disaster Management, Government of Gujarat informing immediate relief response and plans for continuity by Janvikas and its associates and obtaining necessary permission to reach out communities.
- Letter to ACS- Additional Chief Secretary - Home, Government of Gujarat providing recommendation regarding provision of cooked food and water to stranded Migrant Laborers.

FOOD & BASIC SUPPORT



DRY RATION & HYGIENE KIT DISTRIBUTION

- 7511 kits distributed - 37,555 individuals supported
- 1300 migrant workers were provided loose ration at IIMA construction site and Thaltej
- REACH:- Ahmedabad, Petlad, Khambhat, Himmatnagar, Panchmahal, Kheda, Nakhatrana in Kutch, Jambusar, Vadodara in the state of Gujarat, as well as in Delhi.
- Collaborated: Aatapi, Sahaj, Muslim Women forum, Dalit Shakti Kendra, KMVS



DRY FOOD PACKETS DISTRIBUTION TO MIGRANTS LEAVING BY TRAINS TO THEIR HOMETOWNS

- 14040 dry food packets distribution to migrants leaving by train from Ahmedabad in collaboration with Collector - Ahmedabad
- 20000 biscuit packets were supplied to migrants leaving by train from Gandhinagar in collaboration with Collector - Gandhinagar
- 5749 daily wagers provided with food packets in Ahmedabad and surrounding areas with the support of local donors and community engagement.



SUPPORT TO MIGRANTS LEAVING FOR HOMETOWN ON FOOT




2500 Food packets with water, medicine, foot wear, etc.. provided to migrants on foot to their home town on Gujarat - Rajasthan corridor. (Route -Gandhinagar to Ratanpur Rajasthan)

SELF-HELP DIGNITY COMMUNITY KITCHENS

- Total 5100 migrants benefitted with 2,65,200 meals
- 12 community kitchens were operational and fed 4500 migrant workers twice a day in collaboration with DCP Zone-5 of Ahmedabad
- The community kitchen at Gota fed 600 migrants



CASH TRANSFERS

- Total: 416 individuals
 - Rs. 7000/- each by 61 daily wage earner households in Ahmedabad with support of Give India
 - Rs. 1000/- each received by 16 families for purchasing ration in Sabarkantha district.
 - Rs. 3000 each received by 31 young girls and boys who were trained and placed by Janvikas but have lost jobs owing to COVID crisis.

SUPPLYING PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT & SAFETY GEARS



- 500 safai karamcharis equipped with safety gears.
- Location : Ahmedabad
- 309 Health workers of Government Health Dept. equipped with Personal Protective Equipment kit.

SMART DISINFECTION AND SANITIZATION TUNNELS

- 5 smart disinfection and sanitization tunnels to limit the containment of COVID -19 .

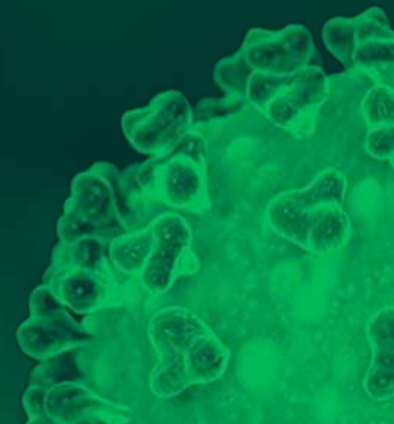


Identification and Assessment of issues by CSJ

Need assessment was conducted in South Gujarat [Adivasi areas], Amreli and Bhavnagar [coastal belt], North Gujarat, Chhattisgarh and Jharkhand. Based on the assessment representation was made to various departments. Government authorities of Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh and Gujarat have recognized CSJ's efforts and authorities are providing CSJ's Law Centre contact number to people to avail the support and assistance with regard for shelter and food.

Support to Migrants

- 7000 non migrant labourers have been directly supported by CSJ Law Centers in Gujarat, Chhattisgarh and Jharkhand in availing benefits of state/central schemes. They have been provided ration, safe space to stay, benefits of government schemes like Jandhan Yojana, Widow Pension, etc. and compensation/salaries from the owners.
- Co-ordinated and arranged travel for more than 14000 migrants to reach their home town.
- Co-ordinated and arranged food/ration for more than 3000 people.



Capacity Building- CSJ

600 volunteers associated with 40 NGOs across the country are being trained in using the toolkit to monitor the entitlements announced post lockdown.

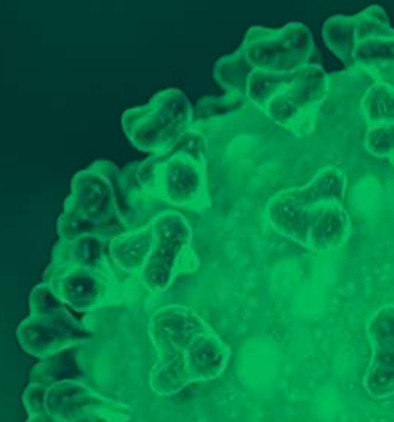


LEGAL SERVICES SUPPORT

- Disaster Victim Legal Services scheme activated for creating evidence for future advocacy.
- Victims supported on legal issues related to immediate relief of food supply, shelter, transport and compensation through DLSA.
- Approx. 6429 victims supported
- Location : Gujarat, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand

Increasing Awareness

- 35 SMS- A mobile solution has been developed by Organization named Awaz De and circulated to more than 25000 people across the country.
- Compiled all relevant schemes/policies and widely circulated the same in various Whatsapp groups.
- Simplified and translated the COVID 19 related schemes/policies into local language (Hindi and Gujarati).

CSJ-Way Forward

- CSJ has developed an tracking app to support more number of migrants in availing their entitlements.
- Facilitate and follow up of entitlements of migrant laboures, women, children, dalits, adivasi and other vulnerables.

MASS AWARENESS

- 10000 voice messages disseminated through 20 voice messages (Awaz - De) regarding various entitlements.

- Supported local police for using sound recording facility from our community radio 'Nazaria' for broadcasting educational messages as well as through auto rickshaws / cabs.

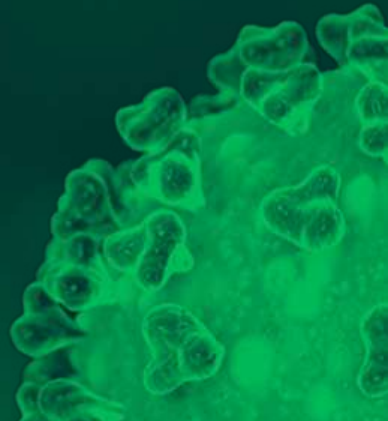
TRAINING & CAPACITY BUILDING

- **Reviving Livelihood:** Support people who have lost employment with a small capital fund to help them to revive their business and their lives
- **Health Care training:** Training community leaders to develop understanding on COVID 19 and creating an awareness and prevention for other communicable diseases and thereby sensitizing the communities in collaboration with Indian Institute of Public Health (IIPH), Gandhinagar.
- **Setting up health care training center** in collaboration with IIPHG and IIT - Kharagpur to serve remote areas along with sustainable healthcare intervention and approaches in our existing programs for larger good of vulnerable communities to mitigate healthcare risks.





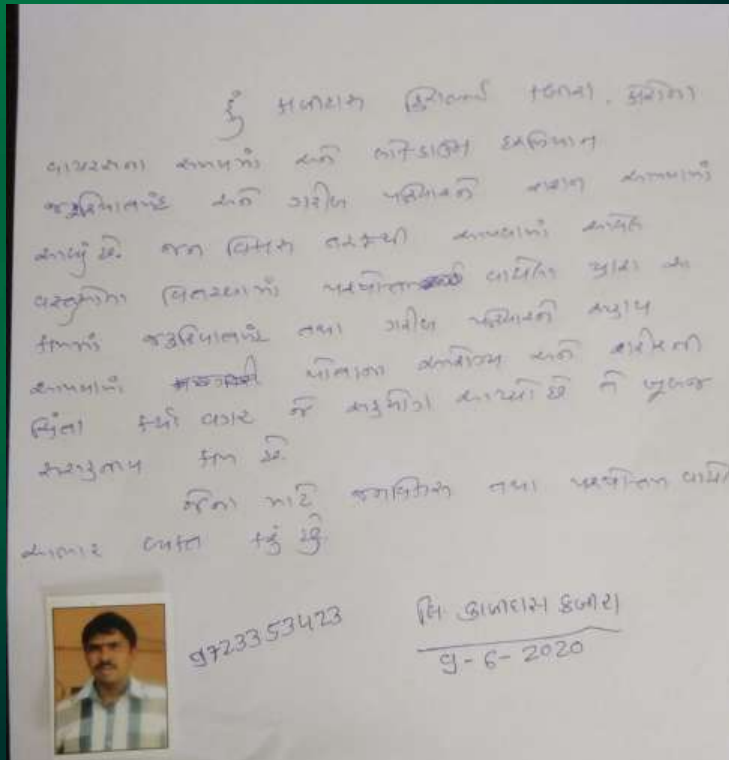
